NATIONAL PARK TRIVIA

1. **Yellowstone National Park** is the oldest U.S. National Park, it was established on March 1, 1872. It spans 3,472 square miles with 96% of the park being located in Wyoming, another 3% in Montana, and 1% in Idaho.
2. **Crater Lake National Park** is the location of Crater Lake, which is the deepest lake in the United States at 1,943 feet deep. It is also one of the 10 deepest lakes in the world.
3. **Sequoia National Park** is the location of Mount Whitney, which is the highest summit in the contiguous United States with an elevation of 14,505 feet.
